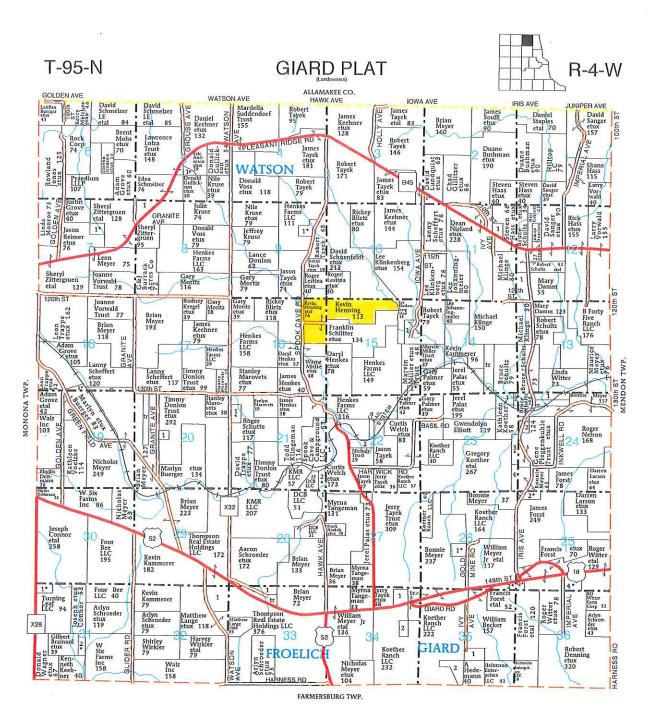

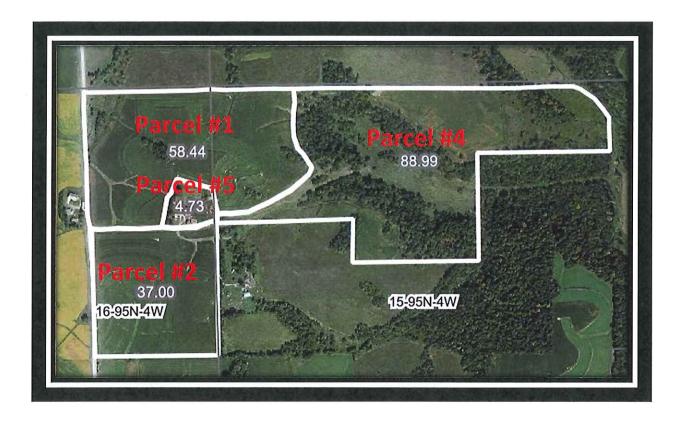

**Parcel #1** — Consists of 58.44 acres with 52.92 tillable acres with an average CSR2 of 49.5. Estimated taxes for Parcel #1 are \$1,600/year.

**Parcel #2** — Consists of 37.00 acres with 36.16 tillable acres with an average CSR2 of 60.6. Estimated taxes for Parcel #2 are \$1,360/year.

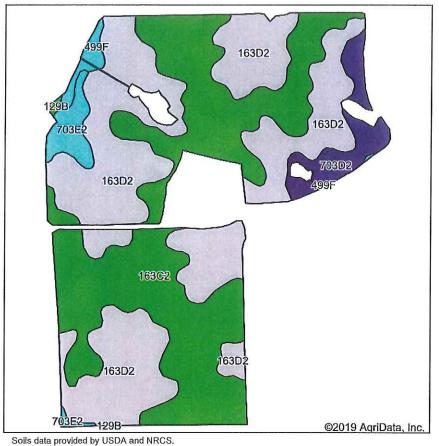

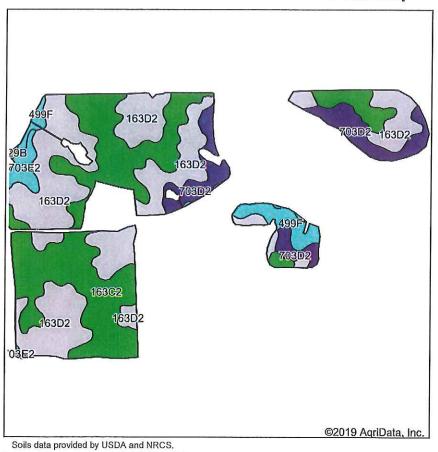
